Re: Sales Tax Exempt Purchases in Texas

Please read the following instructions and explanations carefully:

In order to claim an exemption from sales tax on purchases in TX, a copy of the TX Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate, as attached below, must be presented to the vendor at the time of purchase. Make sure to fill in the purchasing department address and phone number, seller information and description of purchase.

In addition, payment for the item and/or services must be made using university funds (ex. GW check or GW p-card). If payment is made using a personal credit card or check, you will have to pay sales tax on the item and/or services, even if later you will be reimbursed by the university.

TX excludes the hotel occupancy tax from this exemption but otherwise this should work for most purchases.

Note that GW sales tax exemptions <u>cannot</u> be used for personal purchases.

## **Texas Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certification**
